### PELICAN MICRO CASE 1010

**The claim:** "The Pelican Micro Case Series is perfect for your cell phones, PDAs, pagers and other personal gadgets and items."

**The cost:** About \$9.50 at [www.cableorganizer.com](http://www.cableorganizer.com) or other retailers found at [www.pelican.com](http://www.pelican.com).



**The verdict:** The 1010 model of Pelican's series of micro cases is among the least expensive. It isn't the most beautiful or functional, but it does protect what's inside, whether you run it over with a sport utility vehicle or play fetch with it with your Labrador retriever. Pelican's micro case series is crushproof — enduring up to 5,000 pounds — watertight and has an automatic purge valve. It can withstand temperatures as low as 10 degrees below zero or as high as 200 degrees, although the gadget inside probably won't. And the cases have impact-absorbing liners to help guard against those accidental drops. The 1010 model measures 4.37 by 2.87 by 1.68 inches inside and weighs 6.35 ounces. But there are larger models if your gadget doesn't fit those specs. The 1010 comes in black, red, blue and yellow.
