PROACTIVE SPORTS RADIO-CONTROLLED INCRED-A-BALL

> **Get it for:** \$15.95 at www.golf-aid.com.
 This golf ball is good for laughs on the green. It features a radio-activated gyroscope and is controlled by a small remote. It looks somewhat like a real golf ball, but because of a rolling weight and the circuitry within, it does not roll straight on its own. It comes with a rechargeable battery.



PORT AUTHORITY2 MP3 TO FM CAR AND STEREO ADAPTER

> **Get it for:** \$36.53 at www.CableOrganizer.com.
 Listen to portable audio devices through any car or home stereo with this MP3-to-stereo adapter. Simply connect the adapter to an MP3 player, compact disc player, laptop computer or PDA, select the frequency on the adapter and turn the car or home stereo to the same frequency. The adapter provides clear transmission of audio files, and the MP3 device controls function as normal. The adapter can be powered by the included 12-volt DC power cradle or by two AAA batteries.



TEST TUBE DIGITAL CLOCK

 This digital clock features red light-emitting diode (LED) lights embedded inside transparent test tubes and hooked to a wooden stand. It displays hours, minutes and seconds. It comes with AC adaptor and user guide.



FINIS AQUA PULSE HEART RATE MONITOR

> **Get it for:** \$139.99 at www.balkowitsch.com.
 This waterproof monitor uses patented bone-conduction and infrared technology to help maximize swimming workouts. It clips to the earlobe to pick up the swimmer's heart rate by measuring light pulses due to capillary flow in the skin. The Aqua Pulse then communicates this heart rate through a bone-conduction unit that clips onto the swimmer's goggle strap and provides a clear audio report. It can be preset to communicate heart rate every few seconds or minutes, and it comes with a rechargeable lithium ion battery.
