With cell phones, GPS devices, MP3 players and other electronic companions often coming along for the ride, how is one to keep them all happily powered up and manageably organized in the car?

With the PowerStation Traveller, that's how.

Integrated into an 11-by-7-by-4-inch zippered nylon case are a DC power chord that plugs into the car cigarette lighter, and, on the other side, an inner power strip with three more DC "extension" ports that get power at the same time.

A sturdy plastic panel with adjustable sliders holds up to three small electronic devices, whose DC power chords plug into the extra ports behind the panel.

The case is well-padded to protect fragile electronics and

has a removable shoulder strap and built-in carrying handle. An optional AC wall adapter lets you charge devices indoors as well.
