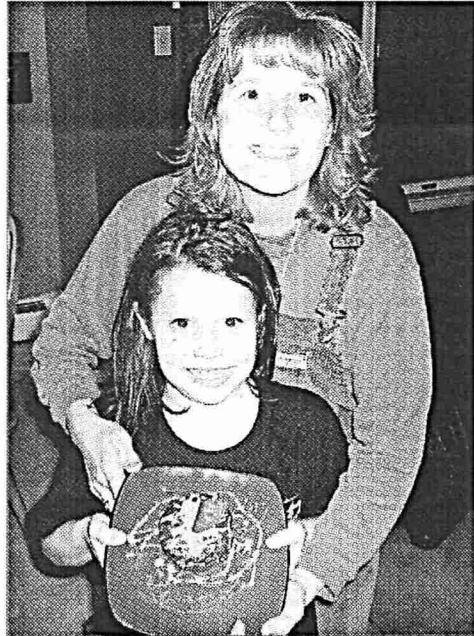


FOOD BITS
