

Vycor acquires NovaVision, moving to Boca

The medical device firm Vycor Medical has completed its \$900,000 purchase of bankrupt NovaVision Inc. in Boca Raton and will consolidate the merged company at the Boca Raton offices, Vycor's chief executive said Monday.

Vycor, in Bohemia, N.Y.,

made the move to acquire NovaVision's Vision Restoration Therapy (VRT), an FDA-approved device that uses light bursts to stimulate brain cells to help partially restore eyesight lost in strokes or brain injuries.

Vycor CEO Kenneth Co-viello said the New York

operation and a few key employees will relocate over the next few weeks into the NovaVision offices. NovaVision, incorporated in 2003, had received tens of millions in venture capital since 2005 but wound up filing for bankruptcy in April.
